Indefinite pronouns

Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
SOME (немного, несколько)	
He has got some oranges	He has got some juice
ANY (сколько-нибудь)	
Have you got any oranges? Yes, I have.	Have you got any juice? No, I haven't got any juice.
MANY (много) There many eggs in the fridge.	MUCH (много) They have got much milk in the fridge.
FEW (мало) I've got few books at home.	LITTLE (мало) I've got little free time.


